Our Respite applications and dates for the 2023-2024 season will come out during the summer.

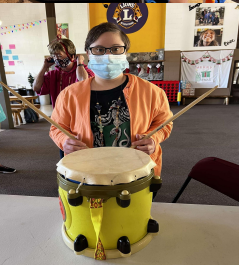
